



**Size 32-35, 36-39 and 40-43**

Directions for the smaller size are before the stroke, with larger sizes behind. If there is only one figure, it applies to all sizes.

**All measurements are in centimetres (cm). For approximate inch sizes simply multiply by 0.4 (or divide by 2.54) or see table below.**

**Materials:**

quality **Regia Stretch Color**  
 50 g #115 Crazy electra;  
 quality **Regia 4faedig**,  
 50 g or an oddment in #1255 turquoise.  
 2-3 mm [size 0-3] double-pointed needles,  
**or size to obtain gauge.**

**Always ensure that the yarn from Regia STRETCH Color comes from the outside of the ball, and that each sock starts with the same color motif.**

**Stockinet stitch (st-st):** K RS rows; P WS rows; in rounds K all sts.

**Gauge:** 30 sts. and 42 rows/rounds each to 4" [10 cm].

**METHOD**

**Right foot:** cast on 56(60/64) sts. turquoise and work 6 rounds alt K1, P1. Cont in st-st with Crazy electra.

When work measures about 4(5/6) cm work one-sided toes with separate big toe.

For the big toe slip last 8(10/11) sts. on needle 3 and the first 8(10/11) sts. on needle 4 onto a holder.

Cast on 4(4/6) sts. to the rem 40(40/42) sts. for bar between big toe and next., and cont over all 44(44/48) sts. in patt.

For one-sided toe band work to 3 from end of needle 1, then K2 tog, K1; K 1st st. on needle 2, then a slip dec knitwise over 2 sts. (= slip 1 knitwise, K1, pass slipped st. over). Rep these dec on every 2nd round another 2(3/3) times, then bind off all sts. purlwise.

For big toe pick up the 16(20/22) sts. off holder and another 4(4/6) sts. along bar, and cont for 4(6/8) rounds over all 20(24/28) sts., then bind off all sts. purlwise.

**Left foot:** work in reverse. Thus for big toe slip sts. at end of needle 1 and at beg of needle 2 onto a holder; and for one-sided toe shaping work at end of needle 3 as for needle 1, and at beg of needle 4 as for needle 2.

**Conversation table from centimeters (cm) to inches: 10 cm = 4" (2.54 cm = 1").**
